## **General Requirements**





### 2-A General Administrative Requirements

The task force will do the following for each member:

- 1. Application for Federal Employment; Optional Form 612 (EMOS>Files>Forms)
- 2. Appointment Affidavits; Standard Form 61 (EMOS>Forms>Files)
- 3. A quantitative respiratory protection fit test required per 29 CFR 1910.134, Program Directive 2005-008 (CATF4)
- Ensure that each member maintains <u>current inoculations</u>, Program Directive 2005-008, unless medically contraindicated (EMOS>Files>Forms)
- 5. <u>Physician Clearance for Deployment</u>, Program Directive 2005-008, triannual (EMOS>Files>Forms)
- 6. Signed a Code of Conduct, Program Directive 2018-006 (EMOS>Files>Forms)

## 2-B General Training Requirements

Each member will complete the following:

- 1. Critical incident stress awareness training (Employer or ESF9)
- 2. ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-700, and the ICS-800.B (Employer or FEMA Website)
- 3. FEMA National US&R Response System Orientation course (Course Code: 9G6100) (ESF9)
- 4. **Initial** and **annual** refresher training at the <u>hazardous material first responder operations</u> level accordance with OSHA 29 CFR, 1910.120 (Employer or ESF9)
- 5. CPR
- 6. **Initial** and **annual** refresher respiratory protection training in accordance with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.134 (k) (CATF4 March Readiness fit test)
- 7. Initial blood-borne pathogen training in accordance with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.1030 (Employer or ESF9)
- 8. FEMA US&R <u>Enhanced Operations in the Contaminated Environment</u> Computer Based Training (Course Code: 9G5410) (ESF9)
- 9. FEMA US&R Enhanced Operations in the Contaminated Environment Instructor-Led Training (Course Code: 9G5420) (CAFT4)
- 10. Complete NFPA 1670 awareness level training for the following:
  - a. Confined Space Search and Rescue (ESF9 or satisfied by Confined Space Technician)
  - b. Water Rescue (ESF9 or satisfied by Open Water Rescue, Swiftwater)
  - c. Structural Collapse Search and Rescue (ESF9 or satisfied by Structural Collapse Specialist 1)
